Description of scientific activities

There were talks on ongoing preparation of papers to be submitted to scientific journals with impact factor, which are the collaborative work of teams from KCL (with much involvement of Vasa Curcin) and WrUT as well as some other European researchers. The topics are related to CDIM (Clinical Data Integration Model), and mobile solutions to for remote patient monitoring, including Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs) gathering. Since the partners were busy, the meetings were intensive but relatively short.

IPR issues were not discussed this time.



Description of the cooperation between universities and industry

The KCL team is recently focusing on extension of their research activities not towards European resources like H2020 but rather directly to companies as well as towards US market, which is an interesting direction that should be considered also for the Engine team.
